ANNEX 1 – MANDATORY CONDITIONS

1. No supply of alcohol may be made at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of this licence.
2. No supply of alcohol may be made at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or the personal licence is suspended.
3. Every supply of alcohol under this licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.
4. (1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder must ensure that an age verification policy is adopted in respect of the premises in relation to the sale of supply of alcohol.

(2) The designated premises supervisor in relation to the premises licence must ensure that the supply of alcohol at the premises is carried on in accordance with the age verification policy.

(3) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and either-
 - (a) a holographic mark, or
 - (b) an ultraviolet feature
5. A relevant person shall ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on or off the premises for a price which is less than the permitted price.
6. For the purposes of the condition set out in the paragraph above -
 - (a) duty is to be construed in accordance with the Alcohol Liquor Duties Act 1979;
 - (b) permitted price is the price found by applying the formula -
$$P = D + (D \times V)$$

Where:

- (i) P is the permitted price
- (ii) D is the amount of duty chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the duty were charged on the date of the sale or supply of alcohol, and
- (iii) V is the rate of value added tax chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the value added tax were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol;

(c) relevant person means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a premises licence -

- (i) the holder of the premises licence,
- (ii) the designated premises supervisor (if any) in respect of such a licence, or
- (iii) the personal licence holder who makes or authorises a supply of alcohol under such a licence;

(d) relevant person means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a club premises certificate, any member or officer of the club present on the premises in a capacity which enables the member or officer to prevent the supply in question; and

(e) value added tax means value added tax charged in accordance with the Value Added Tax Act 1994.

- 7. Where the permitted price given by Paragraph (b) above would (apart from this paragraph) not be a whole number of pennies, the price given by that sub-paragraph shall be taken to be the price actually given by that sub-paragraph rounded up to the nearest penny.
- 8. (1) Sub-paragraph (2) applies where the permitted price given by Paragraph (b) above on a day ("the first day") would be different from the permitted price on the next day ("the second day") as a result of a change of the rate of duty or value added tax.

(2) The permitted price which would apply on the first day applies to sales or supplies of alcohol which take place before the expiry of the period of 14 days beginning on the second day.

ANNEX 2 – CONDITIONS CONSISTENT WITH THE OPERATING SCHEDULE

General

- 1. The premises licence holder shall be permitted to undertake the delivery of goods including alcohol by a third-party delivery company.
- 2. There shall be no deliveries or collections of alcohol to or from the premises outside of authorised hours for licensable activities (sale of alcohol).
- 3. All delivery sales of alcohol must be paid for at the time of ordering. Payment shall be made by debit or credit card, or electronic payment such as Apple Pay, Android Pay, etc.

The prevention of crime and disorder

- 4. A suitable and sufficient CCTV system with recording facilities will be in place at site and will operate at all times the premise is open for licensable activities. Images will be retained for a

minimum period of 28 days and can be made available upon reasonable request (meaning within 48 hours) by the Police or other relevant officers of a responsible authority.

5. Staff will be trained with regard to their responsibilities in the retail sale of alcohol and regular refresher training (every 6 months) will also be undertaken. Training records can be made available for inspection upon reasonable request (meaning within 48 hours) by the Police or other relevant officers of a responsible authority.
6. An electronic refusal log will be operated and maintained and will be produced to a relevant officer of the Police or other relevant officers of a responsible authority upon reasonable request (meaning within 48 hours).
7. Spirits will be located behind the counter.

The prevention of public nuisance

8. The staff at the premises shall ensure delivery drivers enter and leave the premises in a quiet and respectful manner. Delivery drivers will be encouraged to not play loud music or rev cars if waiting for deliveries.

The protection of children from harm

9. A till prompt system will be in operation at the store and used for the refusal of all age restricted products.
10. A Challenge 25 policy will be operated at the premise; forms of identification that will be accepted are a valid passport, military ID, photo card driving licence and PASS accredited identification card.
11. The licence holder shall display prominent signage confirming the company's Challenge 25 policy.
