Hi Amanda,

Thank-you for consulting the Environmental Protection Team with regard to a Premises Licence Full Variation application for Morrisons Daily, Connaught House, The Street, Hempnall, Norfolk, NR15 2AD.

I note that:

- If it were to be approved, this application would extend hours during which alcohol could be sold for consumption off the premises from between 6am and 9pm Monday to Sunday as permitted by the current licence to between 6am and 10pm Monday to Sunday.
- The premises are a convenience store selling a range of items of which alcohol is just a part and that the premises can already open between 6am and 10pm Monday to Sunday for the sale of items other than alcohol.
- We have two nuisance type complaint on record regarding these premises. These two complaints were received this week and both relates to odour and flies originating from storage crates containing waste being placed outside the front of the premises.

Having regard to the above I do not consider that we have sustainable grounds to object to this Premises Licence Full Variation application for Morrisons Daily, Connaught House, The Street, Hempnall, Norfolk, NR15 2AD.
