Hi Jamie,

Thank you for emailing me, it is much appreciated.

I do acknowledge that there are often big differences in promoter's attitudes to controlling the level of their music at events and that this can make a material difference to whether an event will negatively impact those living in the locality or not.

There has been a lot of complaints over the last few months and regrettably local resident's patience has been sorely tested perhaps by less diligent or responsible promoters. We hope that those in day to day control of the Beauchamp Arms are willing to look at putting together a robust event management plan including appropriate and robust management / control of music levels so that future events can be consistently well managed to reduce the impact of such events on residents in the locality of the Beauchamp Arms.

The background noise levels in the Yare valley near to the Beauchamp Arms tends to be very low at night / early hours of the morning which means any other noise sources such as amplified music / voice are much more readily audible. The sound can travel quite significant distances due to the nature of the music (large low frequency component), local topography (low flat land), environmental conditions (high humidity, wind direction) and poor containment of sound in the building (significant break-out of sound from the building from poor sound insulation properties, failure to close doors after access / egress) etc.

The timing of your TEN application is unfortunate given an objection to another TEN at the Beauchamp Arms was heard at Licensing Committee on Tuesday 31 October 2023 and a counter-notice was issued upholding the objection. The objection to the TEN will therefore not be withdrawn on this occasion.

**Notice of Objection to temporary event notice (TEN)**

**Our Reference: 23/02331/PLTEN**


On the 30 October 2023, South Norfolk Council as the licensing authority received from you, a temporary event notice ("the notice") in respect of proposed temporary licensable activities due to take place on the 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> December 2023 at the Beauchamp Arms, Ferry Road, Carleton St. Peter, Norfolk, NR14 6DH.

I am objecting to the notice as I am satisfied that allowing the premises to be used in accordance with the notice would undermine a licensing objective, namely that of the prevention of public nuisance (noise) for the following reasons:

- the level and type of music which is very bass-heavy played during the early hours of the morning when the background noise levels are very low,
- the nature of the premises which are considered to be insufficiently sound insulated,
- the local climate and topographical conditions which affect the transmission of sound to noise sensitive properties,
- concerns that the physical or management controls of noise during previous events held at the premises were insufficient to prevent public nuisance from events held at the above premises.

I have provided this notice in accordance with Section 105(3) of the Licensing Act 2003 as amended, providing you with the reasons for my decision.
