Funded through the Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL), it focuses on transport, housing, and critical infrastructure to meet regional growth targets. The Annual Growth Programme (AGP) 2025/26 highlights projects selected for immediate funding, ensuring resources are allocated to the most urgent developments.

The proposed approach is designed to deliver measurable outcomes, including economic growth, improved community well-being, and enhanced employment opportunities.
	Submission of Village Cluster Housing Allocation Plan for Examination	Place Shaping Team Manager	The South Norfolk Village Clusters Housing Allocations Plan (VCHAP) sets out to allocate at least 1,200 dwellings across 48 Villages Clusters in South Norfolk, in accordance with the requirements of the Greater Norwich Local Plan (GNLP). The GNLP sets out the overall housing requirements for Broadland, Norwich and South Norfolk between 2018 and 2038, using the Government's Standard Method for identifying housing need; the VCHAP will deliver part of that requirement.
	South Norfolk Local Development Scheme	Place Shaping Team Manager	The Local Development Scheme (LDS) sets out the timetable for preparing new local plans and summarises what they are to contain. It is a legislative requirement for the Council to publish an LDS and to keep this up to date under section 15 of the Planning and

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			Compulsory Purchase Act, as amended by the Localism Act. This LDS update will set out the latest timetable.
	South Norfolk Landscape Sensitivity Study for Renewable Energy and Associated Infrastructure	Place Shaping Team Manager	This study looks at the susceptibility of South Norfolk's landscapes to energy generation, storage and transmission projects and provides guidance to assist with determining the design of energy projects, and to understand specific considerations from energy projects in the area of the Norwich Southern Bypass Landscape Protection Zone and within a 5km radius from Norwich Main sub-station.
